DENTAL AUTHORIZATION

Your cat is scheduled for a dental cleaning. This involves general anesthesia which allows a more thorough evaluation for the teeth. Occasionally we will find teeth that are abscessed or diseased which were not apparent on initial examination.

If the tooth disease is significant, our only option may be extraction. In some cases the tooth (or teeth) may be salvageable with endodontics (root canals).

If your choice is to extract (pull) "bad" teeth we will extract only those which we feel are/or will compromise your cat's health.

If you elect for "restorative work" we will refer you to a veterinary dental specialist. The typical charge is from \$200-\$300 per tooth for endodontics.

If you desire a call to make you decisions at the time we are doing the dental, we can try to reach you. Unfortunately, we can not predict the exact time we will do the procedure. If we cannot reach you by phone at the time we will need to let your cat wake up from anesthesia. Subsequent anesthesia will be required to complete the dental procedure, the additional cost for a second anesthesia and for an additional day's stay in the hospital.

Remember, we only extract teeth if we feel they will compromise your cat's health.
