## Kitten Supply List: What to Have on Hand for Your New Kitten

### Essentials to Have Ready Before the Kitten Arrives:

- High protein canned food
- Non-plastic food and water dish
- Two litter boxes & scoop
- Unscented cat litter that is digestible in case cat eats it (corn or wheat-based)
- Comfortable cat bed/bedding
- Cat carrier
- Nail trimmer

### For Developmental & Environmental Enrichment (3-8 Weeks):

- Scratching post (cardboard or sisal)
- Collar with identification if cat goes outside, preferably reflective (for visibility) and break-away (for safety)
- Wand toys for supervised playtime
- Bat-around toys (fur mice, crinkly balls, etc.)
- Treat dispensing food ball and various meat treats
- Cat tree/tower for cat to climb and rest on
- Comb/brush for grooming

### At 6 Months and Beyond:

- Larger litter box (1.5 times the length of the cat)
- Unscented clay litter, if desired (gradually transition litter)
- Larger Collar if needed ( if cat goes outdoors)
- Catnip and/or honeysuckle toys (kittens do not respond to catnip until this time)
- Dental care products including toothbrush, toothpaste, rinse and/or dental chews (introduce at 8-12 months or when adult teeth come in)
